#### **COMMUNICATIONS AND MEDIA**

#### **COST OF LIVING**

The Roanoke Valley has a lower cost of living than the national average according to the ACCRA Cost of Living Index. The Valley's cost of living is 86.9, below the national average of 100. ACCRA compares groceries, housing, utilities, transportation, health care, and miscellaneous goods and services for 301 urban areas.

#### **DRIVER'S LICENSE/AUTO REGISTRATION**

A Virginia driver's license is required after residence has been established. A person must be 16 years and three months of age to obtain a Virginia driver's license.

To license an automobile in Virginia, a valid title of ownership must be established with the state and proof of sales and use tax furnished. Vehicles must be inspected annually.

#### GOVERNMENT

Virginia cities and counties operate as separate governmental units. The counties of Botetourt, Craig, Franklin, and Roanoke each employ a county administrator and have an elected board of supervisors. Vinton is an incorporated town within Roanoke County. Roanoke and Salem are independent cities. Vinton, Roanoke, and Salem have the council-manager form of government, with a mayor serving as chair of the council. Virginia Individual Income Tax Rates:

Less than \$3,000: 2% of federal adjusted gross income\* \$3,001 - \$5,000: \$60 + 3% of excess over \$3,000 \$5,001 - \$17,000: \$120 + 5% of excess over \$5,000 More than \$17,001: \$720 + 5.75% of excess over \$17,000

#### Sales Tax:

Sales tax in Virginia is 5.3% (excluding prescription medicine) plus 4% to 7% meals tax on prepared food in most localities in the area.

#### Property Tax:

Taxes on real estate and tangible personal property are levied and collected by local authorities. All real estate assessments are made at 100% of the market value. Each municipality uses a different assessment for personal property tax.
